

Architecture Committee Charge

Approved by the Vestry June 12, 2018

1. Purpose

The Architecture Committee reviews any proposed modifications to the building and grounds at St. John's to ensure that such modifications complement the architectural style of the building.

2. Membership

The Architectural Committee shall consist of the Junior Warden, a Vestry Facilities Liaison, representatives from each liaison area, and others as appointed by the Vestry. Committee members shall serve for no more than three years without re-appointment.

3. Meeting Frequency

The Architecture Committee shall meet as needs arise. Committee meetings shall be open and announced to the congregation. Its activities shall be reported as part of Facilities' annual report to the membership.

4. Role and Function of the Committee

- Any modification to the building and grounds, whether funded by gift or otherwise, shall be considered by the committee to ensure that any modification, fittings, or furniture complement the architectural style of the building.
- As major modifications are planned, the Committee shall consult with architects, as needed.
- Those modifications that require expenditures of more than \$350 will require Vestry approval.
