It is your choice whether you use your gross income (before taxes) or net income (after taxes) for your "annual income" figure.
The amounts in this chart are monthly. If your annual income is $\$ 60,000$, giving $\$ 500$ per month is a tithe. (If your income is $\$ 60,000$ and you are currently giving $\$ 100 /$ month, you are at the $2 \%$ level.) Find where you currently are in this chart and consider moving one step to the right, if your finances allow.
