Voting

Pick up your ballot at one of the CPF Forums, only one ballot per adult St. John's member. We will be using the rank-choice voting process, the same process used for elections in Maine, Alaska, and some US cities, as well as Australia and New Zealand. You rank the projects, from 1st choice to 7th and then deposit the ballot in the ballot box.
