#### \* Narration \*

October Minutes were discussed while I was out of the room. Upon my return, Eliza suggested the conversation around the Transition Team Leader should be lifted out of the middle of the Nomination section and given its own section — for clarification. I pointed out that wasn't the way it happened, Debra said, one doesn't always remember correctly. Eliza said it was the mind of the people present. There was no vote. Win said approval of October Minutes would be moved to the December Meeting.

**Senior Warden Report Win:** Vestry retreat Jan 12,13,14. Friday - Sunday. St. Francis in San Juan Baptista. In the past people paid for room & board. (Nelson will sort out whether everyone will pay the Retreat House separately, or if someone will collect the money to pay together.)

How we doing? We're doing ok. (Speedy list of good things.) If there's something you're concerned about talk to me and we'll see what we can do.

**Junior Warden, Debra:** I'm enjoying listening to people coming up to tell me things, which I pass along to appropriate people. . . (then I listen to the appropriate people say why they think the complaint is not valid;-)

We need a new Clerk beginning in January. Alliee has done a great job, even taking on catching up some past year's records. Kathy Butler has offered to take over as Clerk in January. (Bless her Lord!)

Treasurers Report, Nelson. Cash flow is good. October is up and down. Undesignated money was added to some people's pledges, even if the pledge was already paid. Nelson is doing guess-taments based on last years budget, needs and expenditures. Some groups have not presented suggested funds for what's needed. Major unknowns have to do with clergy. Tracy routinely ran over budget on Supply Clergy. This budget allows us to spend everything people have asked for. The assumption is we will have someone who steps in when Eliza leaves.

Anne: we only budget for 95% of what people pledge, because things happed to folk. It's challenging when money flows from one of our

accounts into another account but, John Melvin feels that keeping close watch on the main checking account is the best approach.

Next Vestry Meeting is Tuesday December 19. Finance committee meets the week before the Vestry.

**Vestry Nominations, Win:** Tom Butler, Elaine Chapman, Vibeke Orsinie. Win will also be on the ballot for a one-year slot.

Rector Transition Committee, Rick Becton: Window is open for Transition Team applications until Dec. 12. Has been well publicized. Transition Team box in Trailer. I have questions re: various things. 1. Can a vestry member be on vestry & Transition team? Yes. One vestry member must be on Transition Team, another can also be a liaison, but no more than 2 vestry are allowed. 2. Can an assisting clergy be on T. Team? 3. Can a staff person or other clergy be on Team? Eliza thinks no.but ask Martha.

What is a typical budget for the Transition Team? Nelson put \$5,000. May not be enough.

Q: Have you received Applications? Rick: We have six applications. will pursue a couple more. Jon: we should have some parents of our children. Kathy has talked to a couple who might be interested. Jon's talked to Kate, who is willing to organize and ask parents.

**Community Project., Kathy:** Canterbury House came in first. 52 Ballots. Had to go through four rounds. How do we let the rest of the parish know about the votes? Kathy Will email all the applicants. Tell parish via enews.

Building and Grounds, Jon: We cannot negotiate a higher salary than what was budgeted for landscapers, but we spent more than budgeted this year. Negotiations for the new grounds workers would save us money. Win moves, Joanna seconds that we give Jon permission to negotiate with new Landscapers for an amount that is less than what we spent this year. Unanimously approved.

**Stage additions. Jon:** Option of two different wood types. Cedar costs double what was budgeted; another wood type might not match. Anne offered to make up the difference. Suggested Motion withdrawn.

**Solar power update, Anne.** The supplier of panels had to change, so we are getting panels from Canada, and they have to resubmit their permit but are expecting to begin in January.
