

Adult Formation Working Group Committee Charge

1. Purpose

The Adult Formation Working Group is an informal group of parishioners who gather to help the Rector plan formation activities for adults in the parish.

2. Membership

The Adult Formation Working Group shall consist of whoever is interested in helping to plan adult formation activities at the moment. Participation will be at the invitation of the Rector. The Working Group shall have a Convener (appointed by the Rector) who is responsible for calling meetings, preparing agendas, and following up on events planned (publicity, reminders to leaders, and other communication).

3. Meeting Frequency

The Adult Formation Working Group shall meet as needed to plan formation activities. The group may meet monthly or only several times a year, to plan entire seasons of the church year at a time.

4. Role and Function of the Committee

- To bring ideas for adult formation programs to the Rector for review and approval.
- To coordinate the schedule of Formation programs in the parish
- To publicize formation programming to the parish at large and encourage participation in them
- To recruit leaders/teachers/facilitators for the various Formation programs offered.
